Dear Mr. President:

On behalf of the Igud Harabonim/Rabbinical Alliance of America, whose more than 950 Rabbis serve in Rabbinical positions nationwide, I write to you with the request that you grant leniency on humanitarian grounds to Jonathan Pollard and terminate his parole situation so that he may care for his wife, Esther. She has been diagnosed with advanced-stage metastatic breast cancer requiring chemotherapy and other medical treatments.

Mr. Pollard's parole restrictions make it extremely difficult, if not sometimes impossible, for him to be at his wife's side during her treatments, or to even go out to get emergency medicine for her.

Mr. Pollard has served four years in the present situation, and kept all of his parole restrictions.

Mr. President, we know that you are a compassionate person, and ask that you have mercy on Jonathan Pollard and his seriously ill wife, by commuting Mr. Pollard's sentence.
